Q1: Following a text that you have a job, when do you put on your PPE?


• Before you get into the fire truck

• A fire travels faster when travelling uphill and doubles in speed with every 10° increased in slope

- Reverse roll it
- Tie a knot on both ends
- Follow up with Crew Leader later to ensure it was replaced


Q8: Name 3 factors that can affect fire spread.
